OCTOBER -- THE MONTH OF THE HOLY ROSARY

On October 7 of the year 1571, a Catholic fleet of Spanish, Venetian, and pontifical vessels won a smashing victory over the Turks in the Gulf of Lepanto, thus protecting Christendom from a seemingly imminent Islamic invasion. Because the victory was due to the recitation of the Rosary (Pope St. Pius V had implored all Catholics to seek Our Lady's special intervention by means of this most powerful of devotions), the Feast of the Most Holy Rosary was instituted to commemorate the event.

Pope Leo XIII later consecrated the entire month of October to the Holy Rosary, perhaps foreseeing a time when Our Lady's intercession would be all the more necessary. Let us not fail to take advantage of the many graces available to us this month. "Pray the Rosary every day . . . In the end, my Immaculate Heart will triumph."
